The Safe Harbor MISSION: "empowering women toward wholeness and equipping them with life skills for quality living". With a background in Education/Humanities, Pastoral Care and Women's Ministry and Organizational Leadership, Amy has enjoyed a hybrid journey of over twenty years of vocational and ministry life in the education, non-profit, and faith-based sectors. Amy has always felt drawn to carry a message of hope into the most grim and hopeless places, and through her work at Safe Harbor with at-risk women, she feels particularly compelled to cultivate a culture of collaboration and holistic healing.
